Gamma Chi Counselor Job Qualifications:

- Loyal and involved member of a Panhellenic sorority
- Complete understanding of the purpose and mission of Panhellenic
- Desire to promote the entire Greek system
- Positive attitude
- Excellent listening and communication skills
- Ability to maintain confidentiality
- Sincerity and honesty
- Objectivity
- Willingness to completely disaffiliate from own sorority
- Available to the maximum extent during membership recruitment
- A positive role model to Potential New Members

Gamma Chi Requirements

- Minimum of a **2.5** grade point average (cumulative and/or previous semester) - **NO EXCEPTIONS**. Grades will be verified.
- Must have participated with your chapter during a prior formal membership recruitment.
- Must attend all required events. This includes: training sessions, the overnight retreat, and participation in mandatory task updates. You will also be expected to attend phone calling, assigned orientations, and assigned PR events. Fines will be assessed for each missed assigned event. More than 2 absences will result in removal from the team. The fine for each absence is as follows:

Event	1st Occurrence	2nd Occurrence
Orientation Session	\$15	\$20
Phone Calling	\$25	\$30
PR event	\$30	\$40

Tardiness or leaving an event early will result in ½ of what the fine would have been for an absence. This is defined as arriving 15 minutes after the scheduled time for an event to take place or leaving 15 minutes before it should end.

The third absence will result in removal from the recruitment team.

- Must live in the residence hall for the entire required stay. Must sleep in the residence hall every night once checked in. Must adhere to a curfew of 10:00 PM beginning the night before Open House Day until Bid Day Morning. Must turn in labeled cell phones before preference parties begin and will be given back following bid distribution.
- Everyone is expected to adhere to the high standards of conduct and living by the Panhellenic Creed. This means that everyone should live up to the expectations regarding human dignity, responsibility, education and sorority pride. This includes, but is not limited to, the use of alcohol during the membership recruitment process.
